SAMSUNG 25HR SKATEPARK— Event Policy and FAQs

What is Samsung 25hr Skatepark?

It's the worlds first 25-hour skatepark in the heart of West London, at the iconic BaySixty6. You can free skate, get lessons with Team Galaxy skaters, or join in the skate jam. The event space is hosting multiple free activities, including photo and gaming moments with the Galaxy S25 Ultra, and a range of sessions and workshops.

Where is the Samsung 25hr Skatepark?

The 25hr Skatepark will take place at the iconic BaySixty6 in the heart of West London. BaySixty6, 65 - 66 Acklam Rd, London, W10 5YU

When is the Samsung 25hr Skate Park?

The 25hr Skatepark will begin with a Skate Jam with our Team Galaxy Skaters from 20:00 - 22:00 on March 19th. Free to register skate Sessions & activities will continue between 10:00 - 19.00 on March 20th.

How many people are allowed in the event at once?

We can host up to 175 people at any given time.

Do you need to register for The 25hr Skatepark?

You do not need to book tickets to enter, however you are able to book tickets to attend our sessions and we would advise this to avoid disappointment. You can book onto events on https://skateboardgb.org/samsung-25hr-skatepark/, or you can walk up on the day at the event, pending remaining slots available (first come, first served).

Do I need to be over 18 to enter The 25hr Skatepark?

Under 18's can enter The 25hr Skatepark if they are accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 and waivers are signed by parents or Guardians. Please note, due to the nature of the event, ID checks will be implemented so please ensure you are joined by an adult to avoid entry refusal.

Why do I need to sign a waiver to enter The 25hr Skate Park?

You will need to sign a waiver in order to; participate in any skating and programme activity, participate in and have your data held for any on-site competition fulfilment, ensure you are happy to be captured on camera at the event.

Can I enter The 25hr Skatepark if I refuse to sign a waiver?

Unfortunately not – you must sign the waiver in order to gain entry to the park.

Can I leave The 25hr Skatepark and come back inside?

No. We are operating a one-in one-out policy on the door and so once you leave, re-entry will not be permitted. You can only leave the venue to access our smoking area.

Are there any rules or restrictions at The 25hr Skatepark?

Whilst we want all guests to enjoy themselves, we simply ask you to be considerate of other guests and our neighbours. We ask you to keep noise to a minimum when entering and exiting the venue, especially after 10pm on 19th March. Anyone suspected of being intoxicated either on arrival/during the event, or showing signs of anti-social behaviour, will be asked to leave or removed. You need to adhere to the Event Policy, Event rules, and Event staff directions and orders.

Is there a First Aid onsite at The 25hr Skatepark?

Yes. We will have a number of First Aiders available throughout alongside a dedicated medic. Please speak to a member of staff if you are seeking medical support.

Do you store any of my personal information?

If you agree to it, we will store your information for Samsung Electronics UK Marketing. Personal data will not be passed on to another third party.

Will photos or videos be taken of me?

There will be photographers and videographers at The 25hr Skatepark who will be capturing content for use. There is a chance you may be captured as part of this. If you do not wish to be captured, please let a member of our team know upon entry to the event. Please note – our 25hr Skatepark experience is a Camera focus event, so you may be entry if you do not wish to be photographed, and/or filmed, as we cannot guarantee this.

What will the footage be used for?

Any footage captured at The 25hr Skatepark will be used for Samsung Electronics UK and Skateboard GB's own commercial use to either promote or recap the event across channels such as Samsung.com, skateboardgb.org, https://www.baysixty6.com/new-home-page/, YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, snapchat.

Can I smoke? If yes, where?

Smoking or vaping is not permitted inside the premises. You will need to exit via the main entrance and access the smoking area. Please consider our neighbours whilst in the space and keep noise to a minimum.

Do you have toilets?

Yes, there are toilets onsite including an accessible WC.

How accessible is The 25hr Skatepark?

The venue is accessible and has an accessible WC. Please let a team member know if you need any additional support.

Is there Wi-Fi I can use?

Yes, free Wi-Fi is available, provided by our partner, EE UK Limited.

Do you have somewhere I can store my coats/bags?

Yes, we will have a free cloakroom where you can store your belonging. Please note we take no responsibility for lost items. We would advise you take a photo of your ticket in case you lose this.

What do I do if I have lost something at The 25hr Skatepark?

Please report this to a member of our team and we will do a sweep of the venue once the event has closed. If your lost item is found, we will store this securely onsite. Please get in touch with @baysixty6_skatepark and they will arrange a date for you to collect your belongings.

Can I bring food and drink into The 25hr Skatepark?

We ask you not to bring your own food and drink into The 25hr Skatepark. We have a free bar serving a limited free food & drinks menu catering to different dietary requirements between 18:00-20:00 on March 19th for the 25hr park launch moment. A selection of soft drinks will also be available for the remainder of the 25hr schedule. Please note, the consumption of food and beverages will be in our entertainment space, no food and drink can be taken into the Skatepark itself.

I have dietary requirements, will these be catered to?

Only applicable for 18:00-20:00 launch moment on March 19th -We will do our best to cater to dietary requirements, however we cannot always guarantee this. Our sustainable meat option is certified halal, and we will have vegan and gluten-free options available. If you have any allergy concerns, please discuss this with the catering manager who can show you their allergen matrix in order for you to make a decision.

Will alcohol be served at The 25hr Skatepark?

Yes, alcohol will be served at our bar during the Launch Party in our entertainment space from 6pm -8pm. Please note, ID checks will be done upon entry where you will receive a wristband which will state whether you are above 18. Without this, alcohol will be refused. The bar team may also ID check again should they suspect you are under 18 using challenge 25. A one drink per person per order process will be in place and anyone seen to be under the influence may be refused service and asked to leave the event.

How do the Free Skate sessions and Skate Jams work?

There are bookable sessions throughout the 25 hours where you can free skate and Jam with other skaters. All those who wish to skate, no matter skill level, will need to sign the waiver to do so. Helmets and knee pads will be available at the event for those who need them. Helmets are advised to be worn by all skateboarders. If you are an experienced skater, please take discretionary caution.
